Special Abilities

Fangs: Tuk'ata have a mouth filled with sharp fangs, which do Str+1D damage when used to attack.

Force Powers Tuk'ata have the ability to use Sense Force and Sense Life, as if they were a force user with a 3D skill.

Pack Tactics: When fighting an opponent with another Tuk'ata, they gain +1D to their Attack and Dodge as they work in concert against that target.

Description: Tuk'ata were a species of creatures classified as a Sith warbeast. Also known as Sith hounds, they could be found on Moraband.

Tuk'ata were large quadrupedal creatures whose limbs ended in clawed paws. They boasted a long whip-like tail, a mouth full of sharp fangs, and a row of spines along their back and tail.

At one point, Latts Razzi's crime syndicate acquired two complete mummified specimens. Those mummies were later confiscated by Dryden Vos of the Crimson Dawn syndicate, along with many other goods.
