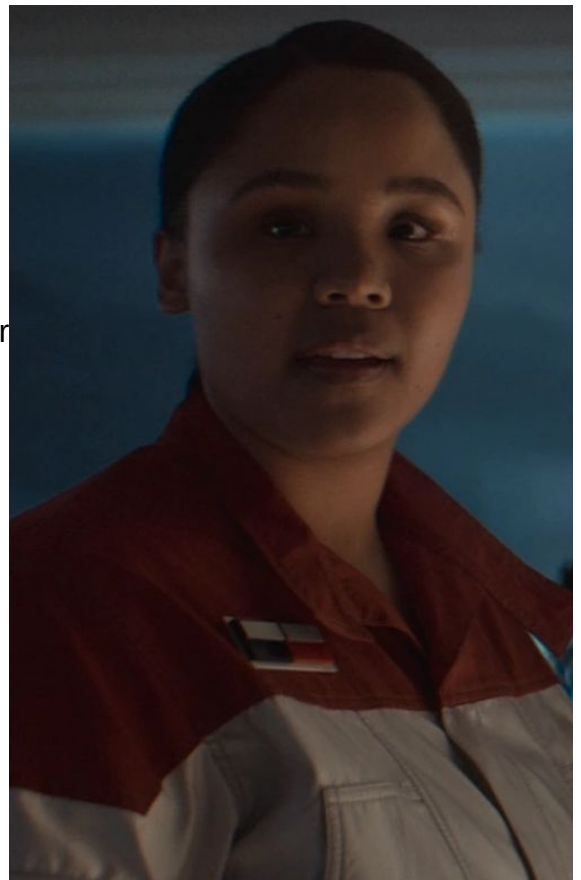

Biography

Pre-flight checks

Niya was a human female who worked for Sienar Fleet Systems during the reign of the Galactic Empire.
