Biography

Routine at the office

During the Imperial Era, a human female named Cort lived in a desert town on an astronomical object and worked as a clerk in a transport office. At some point, she employed Asajj Ventress, the former lead assassin of Count Dooku. While Ventress stood at the entrance scanning customers' cards, Cort sat at a nearby counter and served those that Ventress allowed to pass. Ventress also handled uncooperative customers, removing them from the office when necessary.
